

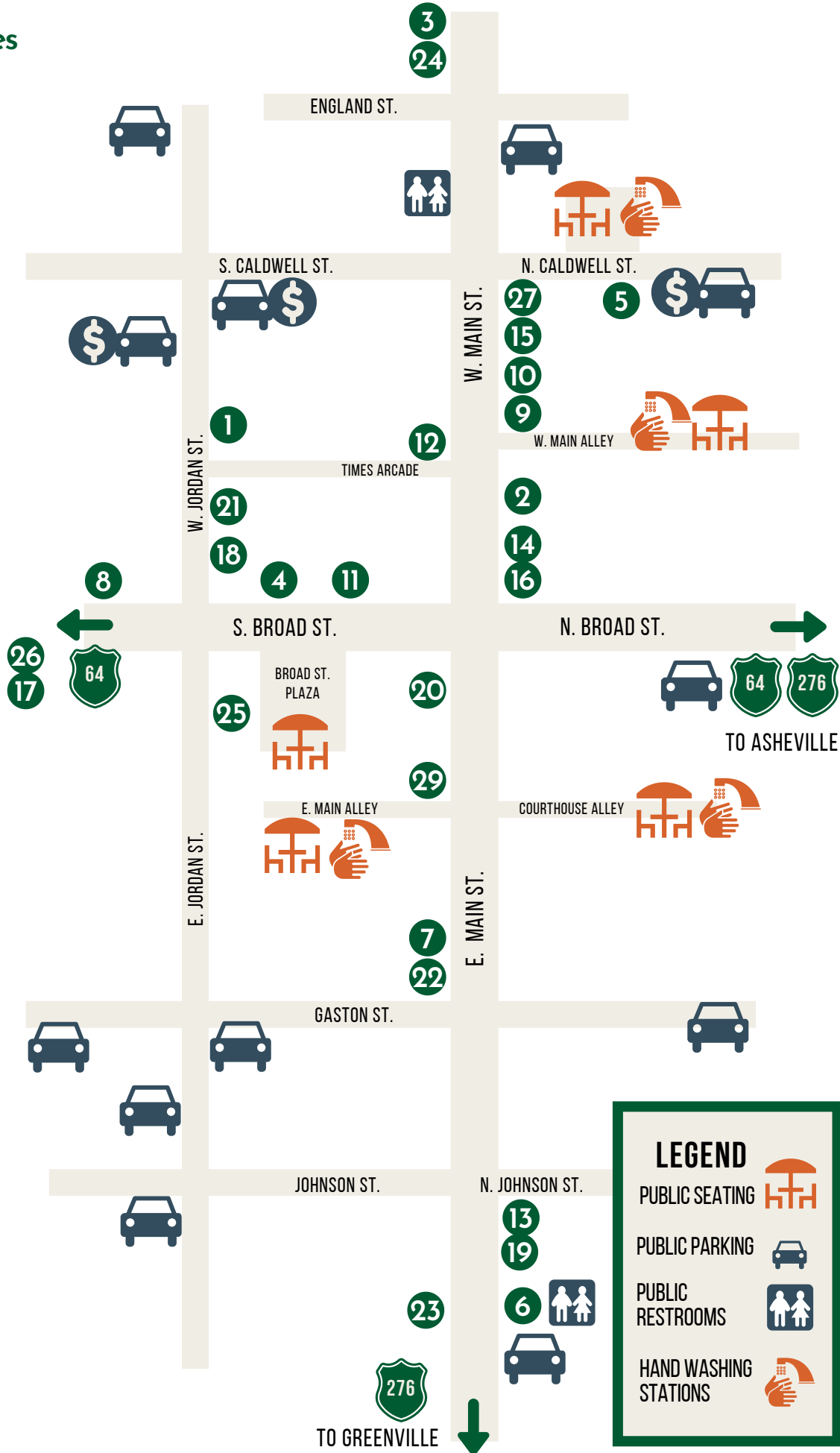


ARTS IN MARCH WALKING TOUR MAP

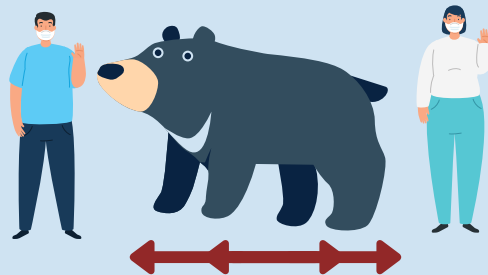
